REGISTRATION

Applications will be available at the church office beginning February 1, 2011.

A \$95 non-refundable, non-transferrable registration fee per family will be required and is due when the application is returned. This fee will hold the student's place until the July book fee is due.

Enrollment is limited.

A current health record must be submitted for new students.

Standardized test scores, previous school records, and report cards must be provided, if applicable.

In order to ensure proper placement, students may be asked to take a skills test.

Each family may be scheduled for a personal interview with the administrator and/or teacher.

TUITION

Tuition will be due each month for 10 months (excluding July).

In July only, payment will be made for student books (estimate \$275).

The first tuition payment is due by August 5, 2011. Failure to make this payment will forfeit the student's place.

Subsequent payments are due by the 5th of each month. Payments received after the 5th of each month will incur a late fee.

Payments may be made by cash, check, cashier's check, Visa, Mastercard, or American Express.

The last payment will be due by May 5, 2011.

The 2011-2012 school year will begin on Monday, August 8, 2011.

School hours are 8:30 AM - 3:00 PM

A Beka curriculum is used in all grades. Classes in Spanish, music, art, physical education, and computer skills will be integrated.

Teachers are certified, degreed, and/or have previous experience teaching in private Christian or public schools.

Enrollment for the 2012-2013 school year will be open to current students and members of NLCC in February. Beginning in March, registration will be open to others. There is a limit to the number of students accepted into each class.

Students will bring lunch daily. A microwave will be available to heat lunches. Friday will be pizza or special selection day.

Field trips will be taken.
